1. Definitions are mildly inaccurate but still in student's own words. 2. Mild inaccuracies when explaining global inequality and 3 main types of poverty or other sociological terms and applying theoretical perspectives. 3. Comes close to length requirement but does not meet the requirement. 4. Does not cite paraphrased class content.

35**D**

1. Definitions contain large inaccuracies. 2. Large inaccuracies when applying theoretical perspectives. 3. Does not approach length requirement. 4. Violates instructions to not use editing programs such as Grammarly.

30**F**

1. Does not complete work 2. Unable to provide understandable answer. 3. Simply quoted definitions, no explanations or examples provided. 4. Plagiarized, used AI, or otherwise cheats. 5. Length requirement half or less.
